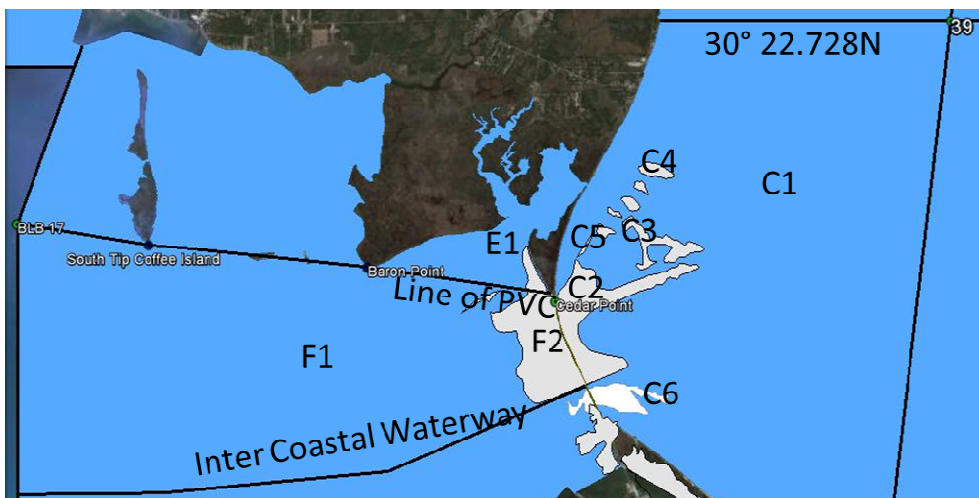

Oyster Management Station and Zone CLOSING:

Pursuant to Section 9-12-28, Code of Alabama 1975 as stated by Rule 220-3-.02 the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Marine Resources Division announces that the following Oyster Management Zones will be **CLOSED** to the harvest of Oysters:

<u>Harvest Zone(s) CLOSED:</u>	All of Zone C (including Cedar Point East, Buoy Reef and King's Bayou), Zone E (Heron Bay) and All of Zone F (including Cedar Point West)
<u>Date/Time CLOSED:</u>	Friday, December 23, 2016/ 2:00 pm
<u>Management Station Hours:</u>	CLOSED
