The scope of work primarily includes installation of prefabricated restrooms and bath house, which generally includes the following:

- Site preparation and installation of restroom building next to tennis courts/pavilion #1 (base bid)
- Demolition of existing bath house in A Loop of the campground (alternate #1)
- Site preparation and installation of bath house in the previous bath house location (alternate #1)
- Renovate campsite directly behind the A Loop bath house to meet ADA regulations and design parameters (alternate #2)
- Site preparation and installation of restroom building near pavilion #3 (alternate #3)
- Installation of ADA accessible sidewalks around each building and connector sidewalks to adjacent parking
- Installation of HVAC system in each building, as applicable
- Landscaping of affected areas to include seeding/mulching or sodding

A cashier's check or bid bond payable to <u>Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources</u> in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than \$10,000, must accompany the bidder's proposal. Performance and Payment Bonds and evidence of insurance required in the bid documents will be required at the signing of the Contract.

A <u>mandatory</u> pre-bid conference is scheduled for <u>March 12, 2024</u> at 10:30 AM central time, at the Joe Wheeler State Park Lodge conference room located at 4401 McLean Drive, Rogersville, AL 35652.

Bids must be submitted on proposal forms furnished by the Alabama State Parks Construction Manager or copies thereof. All bidders bidding in amounts exceeding that established by the State Licensing Board for General Contractors must be licensed under the provisions of Title 34, Chapter 8, Code of Alabama, 1975, and must show evidence of license before bidding or bid will not be received or considered by the Construction Manager; the bidder shall show such evidence by clearly displaying his or her current license number on the outside of the sealed envelope in which the proposal is delivered. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive technical errors if, in the Owner's judgement, the best interests of the Owner will thereby be promoted.

<u>Laws / Ordinances</u>: The Contractor shall observe and comply with all federal, state, and municipal laws, ordinances, rules, licensing requirements, and regulations that would apply to this project.

Open Trade: By submitting a bid, proposal, or qualification, the submitter represents that he/ she and the business entity he/she represents is not currently engaged in the boycott of a person or entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with whom the State of Alabama can enjoy open trade, as defined in Act 2016-312.
