Triclopyr

Triclopyr is a fast-acting, systemic herbicide that is commonly used to control woody and broadleaf plants. Aquatic triclopyr also controls a variety of woody vegetation around pond banks and will not harm most terrestrial grasses along the pond bank. Another formulation of aquatic triclopyr also controls several emersed plants as well as the submersed plant, Eurasian water milfoil. The addition of a surfactant is usually necessary. Always refer to the product label for correct application instructions and precautions. Product manufacturers can be contacted for more technical information or to find a local distributor.
