Glyphosate

Glyphosate is a fast-acting, systemic herbicide that affects plants down to the roots. Aquatic glyphosate effectively controls many emersed and floating-leaved plants. Glyphosate tends to offer slightly better control of some emersed plants than 2,4-D. Glyphosate is usually more expensive and will kill many terrestrial plants that it contacts along the pond bank. Noticeable affects of the herbicide should be visible within 5 to 7 days of application. The addition of a surfactant is usually necessary. Always refer to the product label for correct application instructions and precautions. The percentage of active ingredient located on the front of the label should be considered when comparing product brands. Also, a surfactant may already be included in some formulations. Product manufacturers can be contacted for more technical information or to find a local distributor. Below is a list of poplar brands of glyphosate that are approved for aquatic use:
