Imazapyr

Imazapyr is a relatively slow-acting, systemic herbicide that affects plants down to the roots. Aquatic imazapyr offers better long-term control of several emersed plants than 2,4-D or glyphosate. Imazapyr has high soil volatility and may kill hardwood trees as well as other non-target plants adjacent to the plants treated. The addition of a surfactant is usually necessary. **An aquatic pesticide applicator permit is required to use imazapyr**. Contact your county extension office for information about obtaining this permit. Always refer to the product label for correct application instructions and precautions.
