

## Entry Rules

1. The contest is open to any amateur photographer except employees of the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and members of their immediate families. An amateur is defined as someone who does not earn most of his/her living from photography.
2. Photos must have been taken within the past two years.
3. Previously published images are not eligible.
4. All photos must have been taken in Alabama and species must be native to the state.
5. Eligible formats include high quality digital images, 35mm slides or larger format transparencies, and 8x10-inch color prints.
6. If cropped, make the best possible photo within an 8x10 format; no odd sizes, please.
7. No more than 15 entries will be accepted from any one photographer.
8. Slides should be submitted in clear plastic storage sheets for ease of handling by judging staff.
9. Entry must be labeled on the transparency mount or reverse side of print with name and address of photographer and photo number to correspond with data sheet entry description.
10. All photos can be described on a single data sheet; you may create your own data sheet or use the one in this brochure.

## Categories

- Birds** - Native song and game birds.
- Mammals** - Native mammals (pets and livestock excluded).
- Reptiles & Amphibians** - Native turtles, salamanders, frogs, snakes, etc.
- Other Native Wildlife** - May include butterflies, insects, etc.
- Scenic/Pictorial** - Photos in which natural landmarks, scenery or inanimate objects are prominent; site location required for this category.
- Nature-Based Activities** - people enjoying recreation such as boating, fishing, hiking, hunting, camping (sports such as baseball and football are excluded).
- Wild Native Flora** - wildflowers, foliage, fruiting bodies, other parts of plants or trees (cultivated flowers, shrubs, etc. are excluded).

Judges will make selections based on quality, composition, content, originality, uniqueness, creativity, and general appeal.

First, second and third place photos will be published in the February 2008 issue of *Outdoor Alabama* magazine. Honorable mentions will be published at [www.outdooralabama.com](http://www.outdooralabama.com).

The judges reserve the right to decide whether a category contains work that merits awards.

## Digital Images

**Digital entries MUST be submitted on a CD-ROM accompanied by a data entry sheet and an 8x10 print of photo.** Please send the highest quality

digital file possible. This can be accomplished by setting your camera to take the largest quality photo it can take. The 8x10 print need not be professionally processed; printing from your home computer is fine.

## Prizes

In addition to having their winning entries printed in *Outdoor Alabama* magazine, prizes will be awarded to the first place winners in each category. Certificates will be awarded to first, second and third place winners as well as honorable mentions.

## Submissions

By submitting an entry, photographers grant permission to the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to publish winning photos in any publication or on its Web site. However, the photographer also retains the right to use the photo.

No photos will be returned.

The deadline for entering the contest is October 31, 2007, at 5 p.m. Entries received after this time will be disqualified.

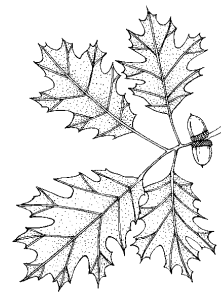
