

- **LOCATION:** 12 miles south of I-20 off State Hwy. 281 in northeast Alabama.
- **HOURS OF OPERATION:** 7 a.m. until sundown. (Day Use)
- **ADMISSION:** \$2 ages 6-61; \$1 seniors ages 62 and over; children under 6 admitted free.
- **RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES:** Hiking trails, mountain biking trail, fishing (jon boat rental available), playground, swimming area, paddle boating and swimming pool for hotel guests.
- **RESTAURANT:** Open daily for breakfast, lunch and dinner year round. Groups welcome.
- **BALD ROCK GROUP LODGE:** 12 private bedrooms sleep up to 30 guests for overnight events and meetings. Two rock fireplaces, private parking, 20 baths, terrace, full commercial kitchen with ice machine, private BBQ/fire pit. Day use available.
- **MEETING FACILITIES:** Bald Rock Lodge-up to 130 guests; Cleburne Room-up to 40 guests; Activity Building/Wedding Chapel; CCC group Observation Tower Room; catering is available.
- **HOTEL ROOMS:** 30 rooms. King deluxe rooms are equipped with small fridge, whirlpool tub and CD/DVD player.
- **MOUNTAINSIDE CHALETs:** Fireplaces, central heating/air, kitchenettes with microwaves, coffee makers, porches; some are pet friendly.
- **CABINS:** Choices include Bluffside, Camping, Honeymoon, and 4-capacity cabins featuring fireplaces, heating/air, bathtub/showers, linens, microwaves, irons, ironing boards, coffee makers, and kitchenettes.
- **CAMPING:** 73 full hook-up sites (\$18 nightly), 3 full-service bathhouses, semi-primitive (\$13 nightly) and primitive (\$10 nightly).
- **GROUP PICNIC PAVILIONS:** By reservation. 3 pavilions, \$40 daily; 1 smaller pavilion, \$30 daily.

CHEAHA RESORT STATE PARK

Take a trip to the highest point in Alabama. At 2,407 feet above sea level, Cheaha Mountain inside Cheaha Resort State Park has breathtaking views and fun recreational activities.

This 2,799-acre mountaintop retreat offers visitors a little bit of everything, from quiet surroundings and accommodations to a magnificent group lodge that can be used for family and group functions. Named by the Creek Indians "Chaha" meaning high place, Cheaha Resort State Park is truly a magnificent Alabama destination.

Located in the middle of the Talladega National Forest, the park is ideal for access to the Kentucky ORV-ATV Trail. Additionally, the park is home to the Cheaha Trailhead of the Pinhoti

Trail, which connects with the Appalachian Trail and accesses the Odum Scout Trail and the Chinnabee Silent Trail. Here hikers can experience tranquility, native wildlife and beautiful waterfalls.

Delicious country-style food combined with panoramic views of the Talladega National Forest and valley below are found at the park's restaurant. In addition, there's a traditional Sunday buffet every week.

Improved camping in the park's campground and primitive camping along mountainside trails offer campers numerous options for

getting close to nature.

The perfect atmosphere for a wedding, Cheaha Resort State Park staff can provide couples with everything needed for their special day.

NASCAR racing is king around these parts. Nearby attractions include the Talladega Superspeedway; the Dale Jarrett Racing Adventure; and the historic Kymulga Grist Mill, Covered Bridge and Park.
