



# CATHEDRAL CAVERNS - KIRKLAND

The Cathedral Caverns – Kirkland Tract Addition in Marshall County consists of 20 acres that serve as an addition to Cathedral Caverns State Park. The tract provides for expansion of the park's trail system and acts as a buffer from future development on adjacent land.

Recreational opportunities include hiking and wildlife observation.

## **Directions:**

From Guntersville, take US 431 North approximately 7 miles to Marshall Co. Rd. 5. Turn right on Co. Rd. 5 and travel approximately 8 miles to Cathedral Caverns Rd. Turn right on Cathedral Caverns Rd. and travel approximately 1.8 mile to Cave Rd. Turn right on Cave Rd. and follow to Cathedral Caverns State Park.
