



LOWNDES SWMA ADDITIONS

The Lowndes WMA Additions in Lowndes County consist of 2 acquisitions (Nos. 5 and 69) containing 1,967 acres of upland and bottomland hardwoods, pine plantations and open fields on gently rolling alluvial land within Alabama's Black Belt. The tracts are managed for public hunting as part of the Lowndes Wildlife Management Area.

Directions:

From Montgomery, take I-65 south to exit 167 (US 80). Take US 80 West approximately 22 miles to a gravel road on the right (If you cross Big Swamp Creek, you have gone about a mile too far). Turn right onto the gravel road and enter the Lowndes WMA. The parking lot will be ahead on your right.
