MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED certificate

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Laborer job responsibilities include all manner of building and grounds maintenance and special event work, including, but not limited to, lawn maintenance, light carpentry, building maintenance, custodial work, and setup/breakdown/and cleanup of rental events (meetings, seminars, receptions, etc.). Heavy lifting and manual labor are expected. Work with small power equipment (weed eater, lawnmower, chainsaw) is expected upon completion of use/safety training.

NOTES:

- Night and weekend work is expected.
- Salary is based on a 40 hour work week.
- Compensatory time off is awarded for any overtime worked. Paid overtime is not available.
- Work is closely supervised, yet individual is expected to work independently.
