

FRESHWATER FISHING

Valid: Sept 1 – Aug 31
Non-Resident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 2; beginning with 9-11-55

PRIVILEGE:

- Allows non-resident 16 years of age and older to fish in public freshwaters of state.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Trotlines are restricted to 100 hooks (9-11-55.1).

NOTE:

- License not required to fish in private ponds.
- Trip license may be post-dated (must be consecutive hours).

COST:

- Annual \$ 50.30
 - Louisiana \$ 60.00
 - Mississippi \$ 64.29
- Trip 7-day \$ 28.35 (valid for 168 consecutive hours)
 - Florida \$ 30.00
