

FUR CATCHER LICENSE

Valid: Oct 1 – Sept 30

Non-Resident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 2, beginning with 9-11-59

PRIVILEGE:

- Allows licensee to take, capture or kill fur-bearing animals for commercial purposes.
- Repealed license exemption for commercial trapping of beaver. License now required for all commercial trapping of fur bearing animals.
- Allows for the sale of furs taken to be sold without additional fur dealer's license.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Trapping must be during open season.
- Methods and equipment are further restricted by regulation 222-2-.30.
- Each trap must be tagged with metal tag (no plastic tags allowed) bearing name, and address.
- Beaver or non-commercial trap must be tagged with name and address.

NOTE:

- Residents of Alabama which have been here less than 90 days are considered nonresidents.
- Must complete an annual report of activity prior to renewal.
