

FUR CATCHERS LICENSE

Valid: Oct 1 – Sept 30

Resident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 2, beginning with 9-11-59

PRIVILEGE:

- Allows licensee to take, capture or kill fur-bearing animals for commercial purposes.
- Repealed license exemption for commercial trapping of beaver. License now required for all commercial trapping of fur bearing animals.
- Allows for the sale of furs taken to be sold without additional fur dealer's license.

RESTRICTIONS:

- *Applicant must reside in state for 90 days prior to the date of application.*
 - *Resident drivers must present valid driver's license (check issuance date).*
 - *Resident non-drivers must present a valid non-drivers ID (check issuance date).*
 - *License or ID issued less than 90 days prior must provide documentation.*
- *Trapping must be during open season.*
- *Methods and equipment are further restricted by regulation 222-2-.30.*
- *Each trap must be tagged with metal tag (no plastic tags allowed) bearing name, and address.*
- *Beaver or non-commercial trap must be tagged with name and address.*

NOTE:

- *Must be a bona fide resident of Alabama for 90 days to qualify as resident.*
- *Must complete an annual report of activity prior to renewal.*

COST:

- \$ 21.40 (*residents who meet 90 requirement*)
- \$ 205.15 (*residents who do not meet 90 day requirement*)
