
Department of Conservation & Natural Resources, State Lands Division manages a number of tracts of land around the state which are available for lease for the purpose of hunting. Bidding for these leases occurs every five years. When bidding opens for the available tracts, State Lands Division will post to the DCNR website a list of available tracts along with detailed instructions for submitting bids. All tracts will be available for bidding in the spring of 2025. Detailed instructions to guide you through the subscription process are listed below.

From the home page you can access the subscription options by selecting the *SIGN UP* option next to the envelope icon at the top right hand side of the screen. Note the icon circled in yellow below.




