

HUNTING

Valid: Sept 1 – Aug 31

Resident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 2; beginning with 9-11-44

PRIVILEGE:

- *Allows resident 16 – 65 years of age to hunt legal game in state during open season.*

RESTRICTIONS:

- *Must obtain an All-Game license to hunt deer or turkey.*

NOTE:

- *WMA License also required to hunt deer, turkey or waterfowl on WMA*
- *Allows use of Shooting Ranges at WMA.*
- *Alabama residents home on leave from Military are exempt from Hunting and Fishing license requirement.*
- *License purchase includes privileges of the Wildlife Heritage License.*

HUNTER EDUCATION:

- *Any hunter born on or after August 1, 1977:*
 - *with HE certification can hunt independently.*
 - *without HE certification requires ‘supervision only’ See HUNTER EDUCATION.*

LANDOWNERS:

- *License is not required for resident landowner or resident member of landowner’s immediate family, see LANDOWNER.*
- *Residency is defined by the state driver’s license.*
