



The Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Division (WFF) has continually increased online registration for public hunting and workshop opportunities.

In response to this increase the WFF has implemented a new online registration process associated with public hunting and workshop programs. This new online registration process will open at 8:00 AM Monday, August 28th. Registration for the 2017 Youth Dove Hunts and the new Special Opportunity Area Hunts will be available.

Online Hunt and Workshop Registration Process

You must have a Conservation ID to register for a hunt or workshop.

For the Youth Dove Hunts you must be a parent or an adult at least 21 years old. Each registered adult hunter must bring at least one youth 15 years old or younger. The registered adult hunter is allowed bring two youth hunter/guests if desired. The adult shall remain within 30 feet of each youth at all times. The parent or adult registered hunter is allowed to hunt.

For the Cedar Creek, Crow Creek and Uchee Creek Special Opportunity Area Hunts you must be 16 years old or older to register.

For the Fred T. Stimpson Special Opportunity Area archery hunts you must be 16 years old or older to register. For the Fred T. Stimpson youth squirrel and youth deer hunts you must be a parent or an adult at least 21 years old.

Below are the steps to follow when registering for a hunt or workshop:

- From the hunt or workshop webpage select/click on the [Click Here To Register](#) link
- Then, Click the "[Sign in to My Hunts to Register](#)" link on the top of the screen
- You will be prompted to enter your CID and date of birth
- You can now register for a hunt(s) by adding them to your cart
- A drop down box on the left side of the registration page will allow you to filter for the hunt type of interest (Youth Dove, Special Opportunity Hunts)
- Select the hunts to add them to your cart
- After you have added your hunts to the cart, click the green "[Submit my hunts](#)" registration button at the bottom of the screen
- The "[Submit my hunts](#)" button will not appear until you have added hunts to your cart

For the Youth Dove Hunts registration:

Once you are successfully registered for a hunt and have accepted/confirmed your registration, you will not be considered for registration to another hunt until 48 hours past the hunt start time of the hunt you were successfully registered for has past. Your registration when submitted will be time stamped and your successful registration will be dependent on the registration submission and the availability of open slots for those hunts. The registration selection process will be run every ten minutes. You will receive an email informing you if you were selected for the hunt, are an alternate or not selected. If you were selected you will be prompted to click a link and accept your permit. **If you do not receive an email within 15-30 minutes of submitting your registration, you have submitted your registration for the hunt but we do not have an email on file to send a confirmation/acceptance email. You can also sign in to your "Sign in My Hunts to Register" page a view hunts needing acceptance/confirmation actions. For the Special Opportunity Hunts registration

The Special Opportunity Area limited quota permits will be generated by a computerized random selection process. Registration will be open until October 3rd at 8:00 AM. You will receive an email informing you if you were selected for the hunt, are an alternate or not selected after random selection process is complete. If you were selected you will be prompted to click a link and accept your permit. After accepting your Special Opportunity Hunt permit, within a few days you will receive an email with hunt unit assignment, and other hunt details and logistics. To view hunts you are registered for visit the registration page and click on the "Sign in My Hunts to Register" link and enter your CID and date of birth. **If you do not receive an email on October 3rd, you have submitted your registration for the hunt but we do not have an email on file to send a confirmation/acceptance email. You can visit the registration page click the "Sign in My Hunts to Register" link and you can view the status of your registration and take action to accept your permit if selected in the random selection process.
