(WFR = West Fowl River, MSC = Mobile Ship Channel,
TIC = Theodore Industrial Channel, GIWW = Gulf Intracoastal Waterway)

- A – S. of TIC, N. of WFR Channel, W. of the MSC
- B – S. of WFR Channel, N. of Alabama Port, W. of the MSC, incl. Relay and Whitehouse reefs
- C – S. of line of lat 30° 22.728N and W. of MSC, including Cedar Point East, King's Bayou, and Buoy reefs
- D – Dauphin Island Bay
- E – Heron Bay
- F – Mississippi Sound S. of line from Cedar Point to Bayou La Batre Channel Mkr 17 and North of GIWW, incl. Cedar Point West reef
- G – Mississippi Sound S. of GIWW, N. of Dauphin Island and W. to line of lon 88° 17.642W
- H – Portersville Bay
- I – Grand Bay
- J – S. of line of lat 30° 27.865N, N. of line of lat 30° 22.728N, and E. of MSC, incl. Point Clear and Klondike Reefs
- K – S. of line of lat 30° 22.728N and N of Fort Morgan Peninsula, including Bon Secour, Fish River, Shell Banks, and Bayou Cour Reefs
