

COMMERCIAL FRESHWATER FISHING

Valid: Oct 1 – Sept 30
Resident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 15; beginning with 9-11-140

PRIVILEGE:

- To allow the use of commercial fishing gear by residents in the public waters of this state, for the purpose of taking non-game fish only.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Not all public waters are open to the use of commercial fishing gear.
- Times, manner, and means further restricted by state laws and regulations.
- This license does not allow the sale of fish. Persons wanting to sell commercial fish from public waters must have a wholesale or retail Fish Dealers License.

GEAR TYPES:

- Trot Line, Set Line, Snag Line, Slat Box, and Gill, Trammel, Hoop & Fyke Nets. (See 9-11-155 for resident fishing exemption for Trot Line, Set Line, Snag Line)

NOTE:

- One (1) helper is allowed under this license.

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT:

- Applicant must reside in state for 12 months prior to the date of application, to quality:
 - Resident drivers must present valid driver's license (check issuance date).
 - Resident non-drivers must present a valid non-drivers ID (check issuance date).
 - License or ID issued less than 12 months prior must provide documentation.
- One business license valid for all locations statewide.

COST:

- \$100.00
