

FUR DEALER LICENSE

Valid: Oct 1 – Sept 31

Resident - Nonresident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 2; beginning with 9-11-63

PRIVILEGE:

- *Residents must reside in state for 1 year prior to Oct. 1.*
 - *Resident drivers must present valid driver's license (check issuance date).*
 - *Resident non-drivers must present a valid non-drivers ID (check issuance date).*
 - *License or ID issued less than 1 year prior to Oct. 1 must provide documentation.*
- *Allows licensee to engage in business of buying, trading, selling or otherwise dealing in raw furs, skins or pelts of fur-bearing animals.*

NOTE:

- *Residents must maintain records to determine the amount of license fees.*

COST:

- *Resident - Price determined from sales of the preceding year:*
 - *Sales up to \$ 15,000..... \$ 25.00*
 - *Sales \$ 15,000 - \$ 30,000..... \$ 50.00*
 - *Sales over \$ 30,000..... \$ 100.00*
- *Non-Resident..... \$ 300.00*
