

GAME BREEDER

Valid: Oct 1 – Sept 31

Resident – Nonresident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 2; beginning with 9-11-30

PRIVILEGE:

- *Allows licensee to engage in the business of raising and selling gamebirds, game or fur bearing animals or eggs of such birds for propagation purposes.*

RESTRICTIONS:

- *Licensee must legally obtain breeding stock.*
- *Facility must be inspected and approved prior to license being issued.*
- *Licensee must comply with State Agriculture regulations pertaining to permits and health test before transporting animals.*

INVENTORY / STOCK:

- *An accurate inventory of all stock must be maintained on forms (provided).*
- *Division issued transfer forms must be completed on each transaction and sent to Montgomery Office within 10 days of transfer.*
- *Telephone or written notification must be made to the Montgomery Office (334-242-3467) before transport or sale. A transfer number will be issued.*

COST:

- *All Species, except of the family Cervidae \$250.00*
- *Cervidae family, 1-50 animals \$250.00*
- *Cervidae family, 51-100 animals \$500.00*
- *Cervidae family, 101+ animals \$1,000.00*
- *Add Non-Indigenous Game Animal Option \$50.00*
