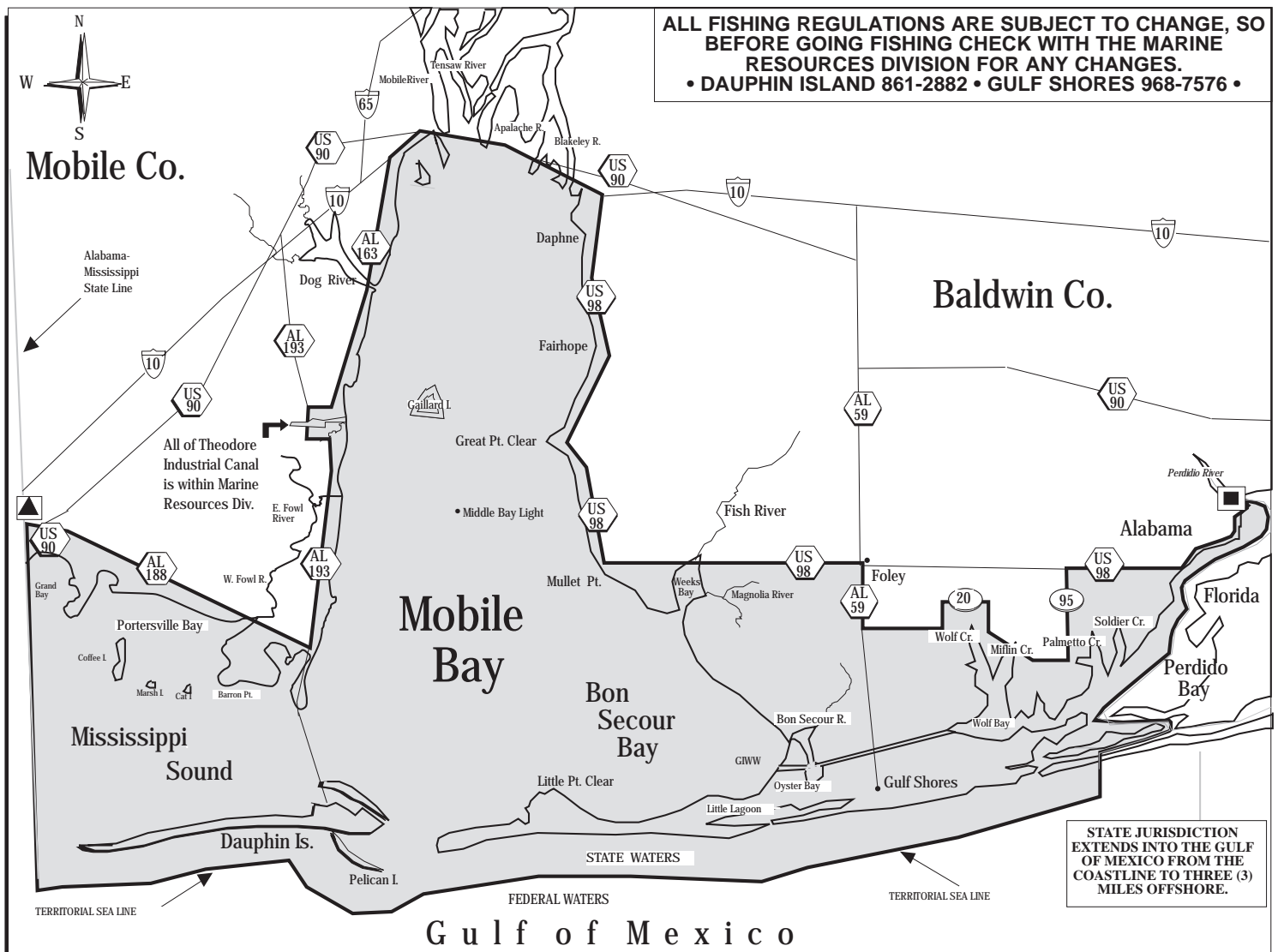

## MARINE RESOURCES DIVISION JURISDICTION


**MARINE RESOURCES DIVISION LAWS, REGULATIONS AND LICENSES APPLY IN SHADED AREA SOUTH OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED LINE:**

▲ Beginning at the Mississippi state line, a **Saltwater Fishing License is required** in those waters south of a meandering line following U.S. Highway 90 eastwardly to its junction with State Highway 188; State Highway 188 eastwardly to its junction with State Highway 193; State Highway 193 northwardly (all of Theodore Industrial Canal is in Marine Resources Div. jurisdiction) to its junction with State Highway 163; State Highway 163 northwardly to its intersection with Interstate Highway 10; Interstate Highway 10 eastbound lane (exc. that portion of Interstate 10 which lies north of U.S. Highway 90 Battleship Parkway) to Interstate Highway 10's intersection with U.S. 98; U.S. Highway 98 southwardly and easterly to its intersection with State Highway 59; State Highway 59 southwardly to its intersection with Baldwin Co. Hwy 20; Baldwin Co. Highway 20 eastwardly to its intersection with Baldwin Co. Highway 95; Baldwin Co. Highway 95 northwardly to its intersection with U.S. Highway 98; U.S. Highway 98 eastwardly to its intersection with the western shore of Perdido Bay; from the west shore of Perdido Bay northwardly to the intersection of the Fla. state line and the mouth of the Perdido River. ■



Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries laws, regulations, and licensing requirements apply to all fresh water lakes (farm ponds etc.), within Marine Resources Division jurisdiction (shaded area). All of Theodore Industrial Canal is within Marine Resources Division jurisdiction.
