Pursuant to the above referenced Code Section, Officers and employees of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and the Department of Mental Health as well as members of their families, shall be excluded from bidding on any tract(s) described herein.

A parcel of land in Mobile County, Alabama, being more commonly known as the BOLTZ LANE PROPERTY, which is more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land located on the west side of Highway 45, a short distance south of Pleasant Avenue in the Touleminville Community in Section 44, Township 4 South, Range 1 West and identified by Tax Parcel Number 2902440033097XXX/Key Number 707505. This parcel contains 30,500 sq.ft, more or less.

All bids received by this deadline will be publicly opened and read on the following day, April 15, 2025, 2:00 P.M. in the office of the State Lands Division. Requests should be made as soon as possible but at least seven days prior to the bid opening date.

The successful bidder shall reimburse the Alabama Department of Mental Health for the cost of the appraisal in the amount of \$1,250 and for the advertisement fees incurred for this notice.

Specification of a minimum bid amount to be considered does not suggest acceptance of any bid which may equal or exceed that amount. The State does not warrant nor guarantee title to the lands herein advertised or otherwise warrant or guarantee the condition of the land or any improvements.

This sale is conducted pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Land Sales and Leasing Act (Act 95-280) and/or other laws of the State of Alabama governing this transaction whether or not included in this notice.
