PRIVILEGE:

- To allow certain non-resident students to qualify for resident recreational hunting and fishing licenses.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be age 17-23
- Must be a full-time student
- Must be enrolled in an approved AL Higher Education Institute
- Must reside in Alabama

NOTE:

HUNTER EDUCATION:

- Any hunter born on or after August 1, 1977:
 - with HE certification can hunt independently.
 - without HE certification requires 'supervision only'. See HUNTER EDUCATION.
