## **PRIVILEGE:**

- Required of all **LICENSED** hunters (residents 16 – 64 and non-residents 16 years of age or older) for Dove, Woodcock, Ducks, Geese, Rails/Gallinules, and Coot/Snipe.

## **NOTE:**

- HIP stamp is only issued electronically.
- Hunters who are exempt from hunting license requirements are also exempt from HIP Stamp.

### **Regulation 220-2-.118    MIGRATORY BIRD HARVEST INFORMATION PROGRAM**

Any person hunting migratory birds (woodcock, dove, rails, sora, Wilson’s snipe, coots, gallinule, merganser, ducks or geese) required to be licensed should have completed a free Migratory Bird Harvest Information Program survey card providing information for the preceding season prior to hunting any species of migratory bird. Each person required to be licensed hunting migratory birds in Alabama should have the survey completion stamp on their person while hunting migratory birds. It shall be a violation of this regulation for any person required to be licensed, having been warned by a law enforcement officer, to continue to hunt migratory birds without the survey completion stamp on their person.
