Resident

Alabama Game, Fish and Wildlife Law; Article 6; beginning with 9-11-44(b)

Many Senior Alabamians have expressed a strong desire to show their support for Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries programs. Even though residents 65 and over are EXEMPT from purchasing recreational Hunting (All and Small Game), Freshwater Fishing, Saltwater Fishing, Wildlife Management Area (WMA) and Wildlife Heritage licenses and State Duck Stamp, this 'license' is available to provide a means for seniors to show their active support for conservation.

Make this voluntary one-time contribution and receive an embossed, durable, credit-card style license signifying your personal contribution to Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries and the management and protection of Alabama's natural resources. Your contribution goes to the game and fish lifetime trust fund and only the interest will be utilized each year for operation of the program.

COST:

- \$35.00

VALID:

- License valid for lifetime (even if licensee moves out of state).

NOTE:

- All applicants must first present their driver's license(s).
- You are considered a Non-Resident IF you have an Alabama Driver's License or Non-Driver's ID and you possess a valid driver's license from another state.
- Applicants with multiple driver's license are not considered Alabama residents and must use their out-of-state driver's license to purchase non-resident licenses.
- License includes privileges of the Wildlife Heritage License. The Wildlife Heritage License includes: fishing in freshwater statewide with hook and line from the bank; fishing in WFF operated Public Fishing Lakes (daily lake permits required); hunting small game, except waterfowl, on WFF WMA (WMA map/permit required); and shooting on WFF managed shooting ranges.
- Replacement cards available at any license agent.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Residents 65 and over are NOT EXEMPT from purchasing the annual Baiting Privilege, Federal Duck Stamp, SW Reef Fish Endorsement or Spearfishing. These privileges ARE NOT INCLUDED with the Senior Lifetime license.
 - **Baiting Privilege** - required to hunt white-tailed deer and feral swine over bait within Alabama for all hunters of all ages (NO EXEMPTION) on private land or leased lands. Prohibited on public land, including WMA's.
 - **Federal Duck Stamp** - required to hunt migratory waterfowl within the United States for any person over 16 years of age.
 - **Saltwater Angler Registry** - required for all residents 16 and over who are not required to purchase an annual saltwater license such as those 65 or older, have a lifetime saltwater license, or fish exclusively on a pier that has purchased a pier fishing license. Registration is free.
 - **SW Reef Fish Endorsement** - As of September 2019, it is required of all saltwater anglers fishing gulf reef fish 16 years of age and older.
 - **Spearfishing** required to spear (while completely submerged) commercial or non-game fish in freshwater or saltwater.
