Sealed proposals will be received by the Alabama Department of Conservation & Natural Resources at the office of Scott Bannon, Alabama Marine Resources Division, 2 Iberville Drive, Dauphin Island, AL 36528, until 11:00 a.m., local time, Tuesday January 12, 2021 for

at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

The work generally consists of improvements and repairs to two boat slip areas. Boat Slip Areas 1 and 2 require some dredging. Boat Slip Area 1: Replace all existing decking, deck piling, and deck framing for seven (7) boat slips. The existing roof and roof structure and existing boat lifts are to remain. Construct one new boat slip. Replace all electrical and water utilities. Boat Slip Area 2: Replace six (6) existing boat slips including decking, deck piling and roof structure piling, metal roof cover and boat lifts. Provide new electrical and water utilities.

A **mandatory Pre-Bid Conference** is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. local time, Tuesday December 15, 2020. All General Contractors expecting to submit a qualified bid are required to attend this conference. The conference will be held at the following location: Alabama Marine Resources Division, 2 Iberville Drive, Dauphin Island, AL 36528.

A cashier's check or bid bond payable to Alabama Department of Conservation & Natural Resources in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than \$10,000.00, must accompany the bidder's proposal. Performance and payment bonds and evidence of insurance as required in the bid documents will be required at the signing of the Contract.

Electronic files of the bid documents may be received by emailing The Architects Group, Inc. at jjenkins@tagarchitects.net and requesting documents for **Improvements and Repairs to Marine Resources - Boat Slips 1 and 2**. PDF electronic files will be provided by return email for a deposit of \$0.00. These documents may be used only for the purpose of bidding and construction of this project. All persons requesting documents will be notified of all addenda by e-mail. The Architect retains all copyrights and ownership of the documents and electronic files.

Bids must be submitted on proposal forms furnished by the Architect or copies thereof. All bidders bidding in amounts exceeding that established by the State Licensing Board for General Contractors must be licensed under the provisions of Title 34, Chapter 8, Code of Alabama, 1975, and must show evidence of license before bidding or bid will not be received or considered by the Architect; the bidder shall show such evidence by clearly displaying his or her current license number on the outside of the sealed envelope in which the Proposal is delivered. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive technical errors, if, in the Owner's judgement, the best interests of the Owner will thereby be promoted.

All responses received will be subject to the Alabama Open Records Act, Ala Code 36-12-40 (1975), as amended, and may be subject to public disclosure upon request.

A performance bond in the amount of 100% and a payment bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price will be required of the successful bidder.
