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## **2027 Alabama NASP State Qualifying Tournament Rules**

Any tournament may be listed as a State Qualifier if the below requirements are met and the tournament is approved by the State Coordinator on [www.nasptournaments.org](http://www.nasptournaments.org).

All State Qualifying Tournaments must be completed by **March 20, 2027**. Rankings will be determined using scores from all State Qualifying Tournaments, and invitations to the State competition will be awarded based on those rankings. Schools may compete in multiple State Qualifying Tournaments. If a school competes in more than one qualifier, **only its highest score will count toward the State rankings**.

By listing your event on [nasptournaments.org](http://nasptournaments.org), you agree to follow the current-year NASP rules as posted and to uphold the founding principles of the National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP).

- Active BAI (Basic Archery Instructor) must be on the floor during all flights
- Only archers from active Alabama NASP schools can compete in your event. (list of schools is available on the site)
- Your event will only allow archers in grades 4 through 12 to compete
- The tournament must have a capacity for a minimum of 200 archers
- Four or more schools must participate in the actual tournament to count as a State Qualifier
- Paper target faces must be used and changed between flights as in State and Nationals
- One range official per five targets minimum
- Only active BAI's can register archers for events
- The range must be set up as prescribed by NASP (In the BAI training manual)
- The range must only use approved NASP equipment (Genesis bow and Easton 1820 "NASP" arrows, NASP safety curtain)
- If you feel that you are unable or unwilling to comply with these requirements, please do not submit your tournament as a State Qualifier. Failure to comply with all rules could result in termination of your NASP BAI certification or termination of the state qualifier status.
