



INTRODUCTION TO HANDGUNS

4-HOUR FIREARM TRAINING SESSION

This class is taught by Wildlife & Freshwater Fisheries Division Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors.

This class is perfect for those ages 16+ who want to learn more about handgun safety and marksmanship in a low stress friendly environment. The following topics are covered during the class:

- Safe handling and storage
- The parts of semi-auto pistols and revolvers
- Marksmanship
- Live fire on paper and steel targets

Eye and ear protection as well as .22 rimfire handguns and all the ammunition needed is provided free of charge for this class. If you already have your own handgun and appropriate ammunition please feel free to bring it for use in the class. Students should bring water, snacks, sunscreen, a brimmed hat, and note taking materials.

There is no tuition fee for this course, participants will only need a Wildlife Heritage License (\$11.70) to use the range. This license will allow you to use this and all other Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Division ranges across the state. A current Hunting or Wildlife Management Area License is also valid.
